## BULBS

It's time to think about your summer bloomers like gladiolus, lilies, dahlias and more. Also it's a great month to plant peonies. If you plant bulbs, don't expect blooms this year, but if you plant larger plants you'll get a show the first year! Make sure you bait for slugs and snails though, those buggers love the small shoots of bulbs and can damage them before you know it.

## SEEDS

Get your quick growing seeds sown like sunflowers, zinnias, cosmos and more! If you've past your last frost, go ahead and direct sow if you want. Plant out your summer veggies mid-month, but watch for the birds though, they are hungry and will be looking for small seedlings to chew on. Check out wire cloches or bird netting to protect those babies while they are young!
