

ANNUALS It's cool season annuals time!

PANSIES, VIOLAS, SNAPDRAGONS, SWEET ALYSSUM, STOCK, ASTERS AND MUMS

PERENNIALS

It's the perfect time for planting perennials! The ground is still warm so the roots can develop, but the cooler temps put less stress on the foliage. Don't expect an amazing show when first planted, think of it as planting for the future! Fall planted perennials will outshine spring planted ones all year!

SHRUBS & TREES

October is a fantastic time for planting all shrubs and trees if you live in a warm climate. Get them in the ground at least 6 weeks before your first frost.

SOME OF MY FAVORITES SHRUBS & TREES: MISS MOLLY BUDDLEIA, CAPE PLUMBAGO, LIMELIGHT HYDRANGEA, CHAMPAGNE ELEGANS CAMELLIA JAPONICA, EL NINO CHITALPA, WICHITA BLUE JUNIPER, EDEN ROSE, KEITH DAVEY CHINESE PISTACHE

FOR FALL COLOR: BEYOND PINK'D BLUEBEARD & GATSBY PINK OAKLEAF HYDRANGEA

BULBS & BAREROOTS

Place bulbs in fridge TULIP, HYACINTH, CROCUS
Plant out 4-6 weeks before first frost ANEMONES, RANUNCULUS
Plant DAFFODILS

SEEDS

Throw wildflower seeds out into the garden

NIGELLA, BELLS OF IRELAND, CALIFORNIA POPPY, LUPINE, SWEET PEAS AND NASTURTIUM

Sow indoors for transplanting later this month SWEET PEAS

And remember to start hardening off your cool flowers for transplanting 5-6 weeks before first frost!



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
