

ANNUALS Add some color to your garden with cool season annuals. CYCLAMEN IS MY FAVORITE! THE WHITE ONES IN JANUARY ARE PERFECT!

PERENNIALS, SHRUBS & TREES

It's a good time to transplant dormant plants! FOR EXAMPLE: HYDRANGEAS, ROSES, HOSTAS, AND MORE

BULBS

If you live in a warm zone, this is your LAST chance to plant your Spring blooming bulbs! Get those in the ground by the second week of January.

DAFFODILS, TULIPS, HYACINTHS, AND MORE

Later this month, you can also pot up dahlia tubers and calla lily rhizomes in the greenhouse to get a head start on the growing season. Aim for potting up 6-8 weeks before your last frost! DAHLIAS AND CALLA LILLY

BAREROOTS

It's bareroot season, now is the perfect time to plant bare roots. <u>Check out this video</u> for more info on why BAREROOT IS BEST!

ROSES, BERRIES, AND FRUIT

SEEDS

Get your indoor seed sowing setup ready! Depending on your last frost, it's time to start getting cut flower seeds sown for spring planting.

EARLY THIS MONTH (FOR MY EARLY MARCH LAST FROST): DELPHINIUM, COLUMBINE, DUSTY MILLER, AND SNAPDRAGONS

LATER THIS MONTH: AGERATUM, CAMPANULA, COSMOS, DIANTHUS, AND BELLS OF IRELAND

VEGGIES: TIME TO SOW BROCCOLI, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER INDOORS. IT ALSO MIGHT BE TIME TO START TOMATOES AND PEPPERS! CHECK YOUR

VARIETIES AND LAST FROST.
